



Here is an easy way to make SoilSoup continuously:

1. Make your first batch of SoilSoup just like you always have. After the batch is brewed remove the compost bag and put the contents of the bag in your garden and wash the bag.
2. Pour off or use one half of the contents of your brewer.
3. Refill the brewer with water. Use warm water if you have access to it. The added water should be about body temperature.
4. Add SoilSoup nutrient solution at a rate of one ounce per gallon of added water.
5. Restart the brewer. Using a kitchen thermometer measure the temperature of the brew.
6. If the temperature of the brew is:
 - a. 86 degrees or more, brew for 30 minutes.
 - b. 76 degrees brew for one hour
 - c. 66 degrees brew for two hours.
 - d. 56 degrees brew for four hours.
7. This process can be repeated for a week or more before new compost is required. If you want to brew from day to day leave the brewer running all night.

You can never have too much SoilSoup!
